## U13 & U15 - COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

### 1. GENERAL

St John's College hosts a highly competitive basketball tournament as well as offering great value to participating teams registered and the spectators. For this reason, ST JOHN'S COLLEGE (SJC) has drawn rules and regulations which must be followed by all participants in the tournament.

These rules and regulations are aimed at ensuring fair play as well as an organized tournament for all to enjoy. The tournament will run over a period of four (4) days i.e. from Thursday 27 February 2020 at 10:00 am to Sunday 01 March 2020 in the afternoon. Pool games will lead to quarter finals, semi finals & then the finals. All games will be played according to the October 01 2018 FIBA Rules but exceptions to these rules are only in the areas mentioned in this document. NB\*\* POSition three (3) – five (5) of the u15 category will play one extra consolation game after their pool games.

### 2. PARTICIPATION

- A total of Twenty (20) under 15 high school teams and Twelve (12) under 13 primary school teams will be taking part.
- Teams will be officially registered after full payment of registration fees and sending the proof of payment to basketball@stjohnscollege.co.za
- Registration fees are non-refundable.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

- Under 15 players must be strictly born on or after the 1st of January 2005. Each school may register twelve (12) players in this category.
- Under 13 players must be strictly born on or after the 1st of January 2007: however, a **maximum of two (2) players born in 2006 and in grade 7 at this respective school will be permitted to take part in the tournament.** Each school may register twelve (12) players in this category. The Headmaster must sign and stamp the team list that includes these players. **There can only be one (1) player on the court born in 2006 from each team on the court at any given time.**
- All players must be registered students of the school and must be enrolled at that school participating in the tournament.
- An age verification process with original ID, passport or Commissioner of Oaths stamped copy (**stamped & signed in 2020**), passport or birth certificate will take place before each team's first game & at any time when need for same arises. Teams are encouraged to carry same every time that they will be playing.
- Age cheating is a serious offence and any team that transgresses this rule will be disqualified immediately from the tournament pending further action against them.
- **No documents, No playing and strictly no exceptions.**

### 4. TEAM COACHES/MANAGERS

- Each participating team **must** have a coach/manager on the bench during each game and ensure that they have at least one (1) Captain.
- Each coach/manager is entirely responsible for making sure that their players fully understand the rules and regulations of the tournament.

- By participating in this tournament, each coach/manager agrees to abide by the rules and regulations stipulated herein.
- The coach/manager further understands that SJC is not responsible for any injuries or accidents that may occur during this tournament OR for lost/damaged/misplaced items. By participating in the tournament, the coach/manager/players hereby waive any and all liability against SJC, as a result thereof. For purposes of indemnity, this clause is applicable to any parent/s, fans or spectators who may come to the tournament.

### 5. PLAYING FORMAT

- The u13 participating teams will be grouped into two (2) pools. The top four (4) teams from each pool will advance to the quarterfinals that will lead to semifinals and then finals respectively.
- The u15 participating teams will be grouped into four (4) pools. The top two (2) teams from each pool will advance to the quarter finals that will lead to semifinals and then the finals respectively.
- The u13, u15 crossing examples are shown below respectively.
- The tournament final fixture shall be shared not later than three weeks before jump ball with info alluded to above accordingly.
- Advancement from the pools to the quarter final will be determined by a **point system**, that is:
  - a) WIN = 2 points
  - b) LOSS = 1 point
  - c) FORFEIT = 0 points

## 6. KIT

- All teams are expected to abide by Rule 3, Art.4 of the FIBA 01 October 2018 rules on page 12 of 94.
- The home team will always be the team featured first on the fixture and will wear a light color and the away team wears a darker kit.
- Please liaise with your opponents before your game to avoid colour clashes.

## 7. a) PLAYING RULES

ALL games will be played according to the FIBA rules and regulations unless stated in this document. If there is a conflict between the FIBA rules & the Tournament rules: then the Tournament rules will supersede the FIBA rules:

- Games will consist of four quarters of eight (8) minutes on the running clock. Each team will be allowed a maximum of two (2) timeouts in each half **30 seconds long**. The game clock will be stopped during any time out.
- **All 3rd place playoffs shall be 6 minutes running time quarters.**
- Halftime interval will be strictly three (3) minutes for all the games.
- The last two minutes will be stop-start in the last quarter of the game if the score difference is ten (10) points and below at any time in the last two (2) minutes of the game.
- In case of a tie at the end of regulation time, an overtime period of three (3) minutes will be played with the first 2 minutes running time.

## b) RAIN AFFECTED – PLAYING RULES

- All games will be moved to the indoor venues at Wembley Stadium and Sacred Heart College situated only twenty-five (25) and four (4) minutes' drive respectively from SJC. **Teams will be asked to have transport arrangements in place just in case the weather**

will affect our original plan: SJC will not be held responsible for transporting any team to the above-mentioned indoor venues.

- Games will consist of **two halves of twelve (12) minutes** on the running clock and Each team will be allowed one (1) timeout in the first half and a maximum of two (2) timeouts in the second half: **30 seconds long**. The game clock will be stopped during any time out.
- The rest of the other rules remain.

## 8. LOG CALCULATION

a) Where teams are tied on points, the POSitions will be calculated by looking at head-to-head results amongst the teams first. Should this not produce a result, then a points difference amongst the teams shall be used to determine long standing.

## b) Two-way (or more) tie on the log standings

- 2- or 3-way tie on the log standings – **head to head will be applicable**; and
- the game results of only the teams involved will be considered. Should the teams still be tied based on the log standings, then points average will be considered (that is, points scored versus points against). If a tie remains
- then the goal average of all games played in the pool will be considered.

## 9. FORFEIT

- A grace period of three (3) minutes from the scheduled time or the end of the previous game will be given. Any team that fails to be on the playing court with 5 players ready to play at the scheduled time will lose the game by forfeit.
- If for any reason whatsoever a team refuses to play, shows unsportsmanlike behavior, or causes a game to be disrupted, the Chief Crew shall end the game and record it as a forfeit by default and that team will immediately cease to participate in the tournament.

## 10. PROTEST

The correct procedure should be followed within 15 minutes after the game has ended. To make the protest valid, it is necessary for an official representative of the team (coach or manager) to give confirmation of this protest in writing. The team representative shall then dePOSIT a fee of R1,000 to the Commissioner of that venue. Protest in writing should be delivered to the tournament commissioner, no later than 15 minutes after the concerned game for it to be valid.

The commissioner will then submit both to the Head of Technical or representative of the technical committee and a verdict must be reached within thirty (30) minutes of receiving same from the commissioner. The dePOSIT shall be paid back only if the protest is found to be valid in favor of the team that has protested.

## 11. TOURNAMENT DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The Disciplinary Committee (DC) will comprise the Head of Technical, one of the Tournament Commissioners, the game in question Crew Chief and three other members elected by the SJC organizing committee.

## 12. SOCIAL MEDIA

All athletes and coaches are urged to apply serious caution on what will be POSTed on all SJC social media platforms. Any serious offences or infringement of the rights of individuals, teams or even the institution can result in the expulsion or disqualification of a team or individual. Coaches and Managers are advised to monitor their athletes' activity on social media. All teams should promote good spirit and sportsmanship throughout the tournament.
