## NOTICES

MUSIC FOR ALL GRADES: Fees available from the Music Department. Music lessons and instrument hire - on application to the teacher (Piano, Organ, Strings, Woodwind, Brass, Singing etc.)

Fees are payable in terms of the election made by parents, either annually, termly or monthly.  
 ANNUAL FEES are payable on or before 31 January 2025.

TERMLY FEES are payable on the first day of term.

MONTHLY FEES are only payable via debit order on the first working day of each month from February to December.

INTEREST WILL BE CHARGED ON ALL OVERDUE FEES.

One half term's notice is required when discontinuing Hot Lunch and Tea.

One term's notice is required when withdrawing a student from the school, discontinuing boarding and aftercare.

On acceptance of a place in the school, a deposit is required which will be equivalent to one term's tuition fees at the class of entry.

MATRIC AND UPPER VI STUDENTS

- Upper VI students taking the one-year Post Matriculation course will forfeit their deposits should they leave St John's at any stage before the end of the final term, whether notice is given or not.
- Students who are boarding in Matric or Upper VI must commit to board for all three terms.
