2. Entrance Assessments



Assessment Dates in 2025:

Main Date: Saturday, 25 January in AM Alternate Dates: Monday, 27 January and Tuesday, 28 January in PM

Booking:

The school will send out information on how to book an assessment time for your son early next year.

What to Bring on Assessment Day:

- Grade 6 End-of-Year Report: Please bring a copy (not the original).
- Small Photograph of the applicant.
- CV: A maximum of two pages highlighting achievements in sports, academics, cultural, and/or community service.

3. Interviews for Successful Candidates



February and March:

- Based on their entrance assessment results, selected applicants will be invited for an interview with one of our senior staff.
- Consideration for entry is based on entrance assessment results, the interview, and any supporting documents provided.

Note: This process does not apply to boys coming from St John's Preparatory School.

Based on their entrance assessment results, selected applicants will be invited to apply for scholarships in the Academic, Sports, and Music categories.
