Hair Policy

Regulations for College students

1. A student's hair should be a natural hair colour and be short, clean and neat.
2. A student's hair should at all times not overlap the ears, eyebrows or collar.
3. The use of hair accessories such as hair ties, clips, Alice bands etc. is not permitted. Hair may not be tucked behind the ear, nor may hair be tied up in any way, including the use of knots or buns.
4. Students must be clean shaven and sideburns may not extend past the middle of the ear.
5. Where culturally appropriate, hair may be braided.
6. At all times, a student's hairstyle should tend towards the modest and reserved, rather than being extravagant or drawing unnecessary attention.
7. No patterns may be shaved into the hair or eyebrows.
8. The school reserves the right to send students home to have their hair cut to conform to the above regulations.
9. Hair regulations are primarily supervised by Housemasters. The Appearance Committee consisting of the Senior Deputy, Deputy: Student Affairs, Deputy: Transformation and Diversity and Deputy: Academics, will settle any disputes in the application or interpretation of this policy.
