

INTERN POSITIONS

St John's College is seeking suitable candidates studying a PGCE part-time to be interns at the school in 2020:

- Candidates must hold an undergraduate degree at the time of commencing the internship.
- Candidates must wish to become teachers in the FET phase.
- Candidates must provide proof of application to a recognised institution to study for a PGCE in 2020.
- Candidates will be expected to participate in a rigorous interview process conducted at St John's College to ascertain their suitability.
- Candidates must be prepared to become involved in extramural activities in both the sporting and cultural spheres of the school.
- Interns will receive financial assistance with tuition fees as well as a monthly stipend
- St John's College will support and mentor the interns involved in the programme, ensuring that the interns fulfil the requirements of the PGCE course, while also discharging their teaching and extramural duties to the school.
- St John's College is under no obligation to provide employment to any of the interns upon the completion of their PGCE nor to find a placement for them at any other school.
- St John's College undertakes to give priority to the selection of graduates from previously disadvantaged communities.
- Any offer of an internship will be subject to admission of the intern to a recognised institution to study for a PGCE in 2020.
- Please note: St John's College does not offer any commercial subjects at NSC level.
