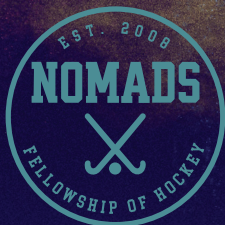

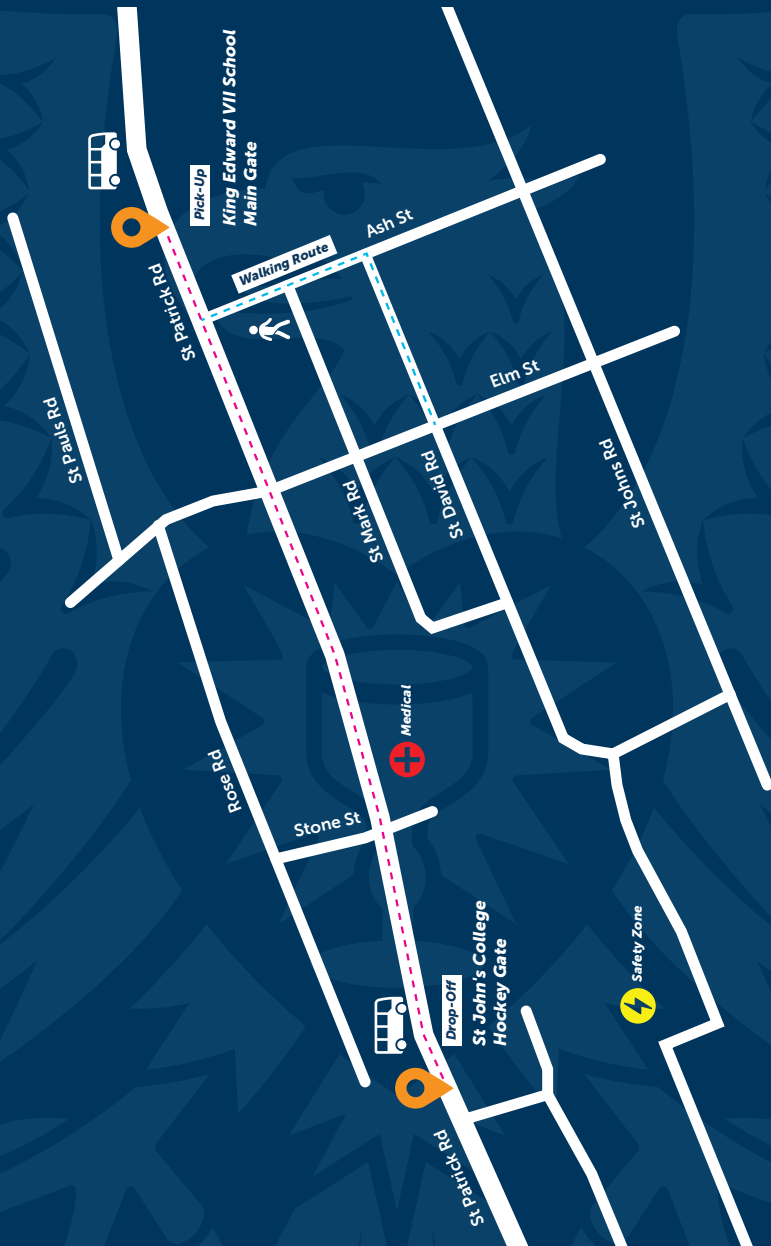
### **Right of Admission Reserved**
