

TIMELINE OF ADMISSION TO GRADE 8 IN 2022

1. APPLYING FOR ADMISSION

All boys wishing to enter Grade 8 at St John's College would need to complete an application form. Please apply online at www.stjohnscollege.co.za/admissions If you have already completed a form, please inform us if your contact details have changed. Please email admissions@stjohnscollege.co.za to update your contact details.

2. ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT

Assessment Date: Saturday 13 February

All applicants will be invited to write the St John's College Entrance Assessment in Maths and English at the beginning of their son's Grade 7 year. We will host 6 assessments at staggered times throughout the day on 13 February. Parents will be able to choose one of the times on 13 February which their son will write the entrance assessment. Bookings for the entrance assessment will open a week before. The school will send out a communication regarding how to book your son's test time.

When your son arrives for the entrance assessment, please submit the following documents:

- End of year grade 6 report (please do not submit original reports, medals, nor certificates as they will not be accepted)
- A small photograph
- A CV highlighting any achievements in sports, academic, cultural and/or community service – Maximum 2 pages
- Other supporting documents or testimonials
- If applying for Centenary Scholarship, submit Centenary Scholarship application. Find application in this link: sjc.co.za/centenaryapplication

Based on their entrance assessment results, boys will be invited for an interview. Consideration for entry into the College will be given to the entrance assessment results, the interview and any other supporting documents submitted (documents listed above).

*The above does not apply to boys who have come through St John's Preparatory School.

3. SCHOLARSHIP EXAMS & AUDITIONS

Academic Scholarship Examination: 5 March 08h00 - 13h00

Boys will be invited to write the Academic Scholarship Exam based on their entrance exam results.

Sports Scholarship Trials:

Boys who wish to try out for a sports scholarship must submit a detailed CV, together with your son's latest school report, at the time of the entrance exam. Please note, boys applying for Sports Scholarship should be of area or provincial team standard.
